A Word from The Pastor

LRFF Welcomes Interfaith Counseling Center!

I am happy to announce that our Administrative Board voted enthusiastically Tuesday night to allow Dr. Rick Landon, Co-Director of the Interfaith Counseling Center of Lexington, to use one of its rooms in the left hallway for the purpose of seeing his clients. Rick was present (via Zoom) during the first part of our board meeting and explained that, due to the Center's increase in counselors and clients, their current location cannot meet the need for space. In order to continue serving his clients, many of whom are mobility-challenged, he reached out to LRFF.

Beginning October 4, Rick will begin seeing clients at LRFF during our regular office hours on Wednesdays and Thursdays. It was mutually agreed by Interfaith Counseling Center and our Administrative Board that this agreement would be a 3-month trial period, ending Dec. 31. At that time, we will reassess the arrangement and, if both parties are amenable, we will draft a formal agreement to continue.

It is important to note that Interfaith Counseling Center is a private, non-profit corporation. It is not connected to any specific church, denomination, or faith tradition. The Center has known several different locations since its inception, and among its former directors is our own Rev. Richard Dwyer, who served from 1995 – mid-2001. The Center is an ecumenical ministry that provides professional therapy through its therapists who are state licensed and have received education and training to help their clients recognize and use their faith resources.

This partnership between our organizations is a glowing example of how we can experience the gracious working of God: *look for where God is already at work and join him there!* God began a "good work" in our church, and God began a "good work" in the Interfaith Counseling Center. May we seek to be a blessing to each other as God's work continues in us – and joins us in ministry and service – in his name and for his glory.
