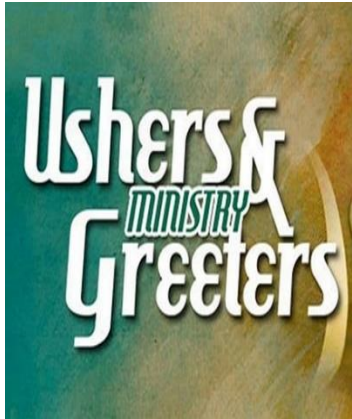

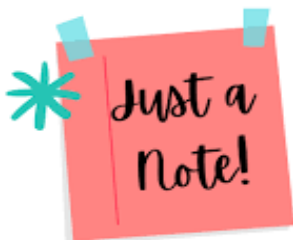

# Website Update!

Several current announcements are now posted on the website, and this article will help you find and use them.

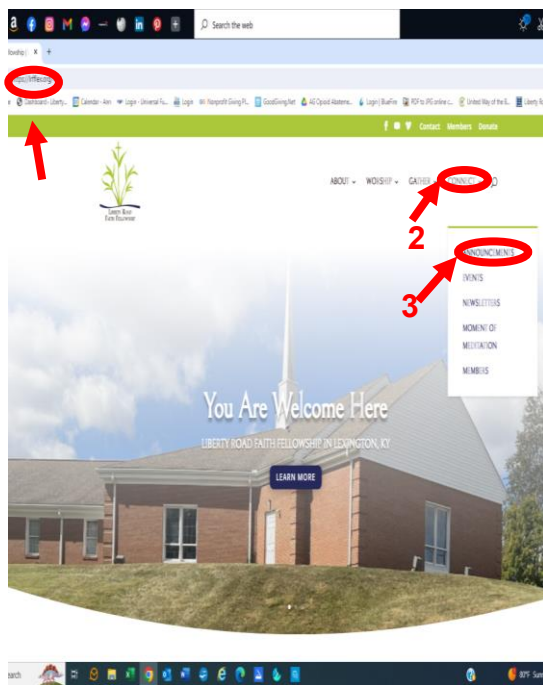
To find the newest announcements, follow the steps outlined here.

1. Enter the website address in your browser –

[lrfflex.org](http://lrfflex.org).

2. On the welcome page, near the top right, click on **Connect**.

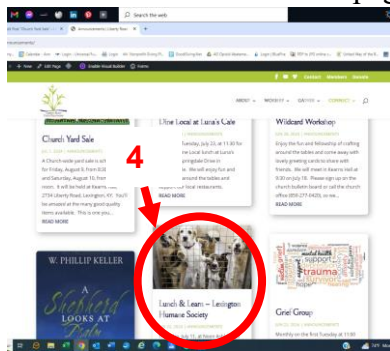
3. A drop-down menu will give you several options. Choose **Announcements**. This will take you to the Announcements page.



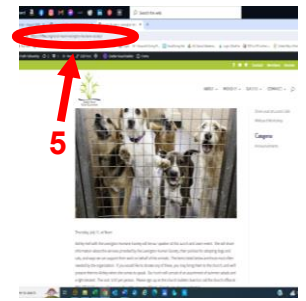
4. Scroll down to see the six announcements on the page.

As our Lunch and Learn event is coming next week, we'll use it as an example. Click on it and the announcement will open so you can read the entire description as shown in the next graphic.

It will include the time, place, and any cost involved.



5. When you open the announcement, the website address of the announcement will be on the address line of your browser, as shown here. There are two ways you can share this with friends.



- If you have a Facebook page, you can create a post on that page, and it can be seen by all your Facebook friends. Copy the announcement address and paste it on your Facebook page where it indicates you can create a post as shown below.

- Or you can copy and paste the entire content of the announcement into an email message and send it to select friends.

To copy and paste, use your cursor to highlight what you want to copy. Then right click on what you have highlighted. A drop-down menu will appear. Find "copy" on the list and click on it. Next, open your Facebook page or your email. Put your cursor where you want to copy the information. Right click, and the drop-down menu will appear again. Find "paste" and click on it. The address of the announcement or a copy of the announcement will appear where you paste it.
