A Word from our Pastor

Do not remember the former things, or consider the things of old. I am about to do a new thing; do you not perceive it? I will make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert. From Isaiah 43: 18-19

New thing? *New thing?* What must God be up to now?

The Israelites and their ancestors grew up hearing stories of Yahweh's mighty salvific acts: children from barren women, Moses' triumph over Pharaoh and the Egyptians' oppression of God's people, manna in the wilderness, King David's military victories, and on and on. God has a good track record of coming to his people's rescue, redeeming them from their fallenness, and keeping his promises to restore them as his "precious, honored, and beloved" children.

Isaiah's message from God to his people was a message of hope. It's as though God was telling the people, "Don't be looking *back* at what I did with the former generations; you ain't seen nothin' yet! I'm not going to abandon you, nor am I going to let you perish in captivity."

While we can trust that God's loving character never changes, we don't expect God to always act in the same way. Our God is a creative God, and he works in surprising and mysterious ways according to his purpose. He's faithful to fulfill his promises and continues to bring new life out of circumstances that we might deem lost causes. God, in his omniscient grace, is making a way for us even now in our wildernesses of perplexity and deserts of doubt. He's already at work on our behalf, in ways we can't imagine, in preparation for our future, and believing that brings with it our consolation and peace.

My prayer for you is that you will find strength and comfort in these verses, and in the words of our Lord, Jesus Christ, who said, "And lo, I am with you always, even till the end of the world."
