First, in addition to what was given during the service as a love offering, the Missions Team has sent a check for \$500.00 to Oakdale Christian Academy. We are impressed with the focus of leading a Christian life being incorporated into the education of the students enrolled in the academy and want to help with that mission.

Second, during the month of May, we are again going to use baby bottles to give you the



opportunity to support the work done by Assurance for Life. This organization

was founded for the purpose of expressing the love and grace of Jesus Christ to those facing an unplanned or crisis pregnancy. The center provides medical and other support services through a free, specialized health clinic, including pregnancy testing, testing and treatment of sexually transmitted infections, and limited obstetric ultrasounds. Specially trained staff and volunteers provide information on all options for the pregnancy along with physical, emotional, and spiritual support with each. All services are centered on the goal of sharing the love of Christ and empowering the choice of life for each unborn child. All services are free and confidential.

Baby bottles will be available on a table in the entry. You may pick up a bottle or two and fill them with loose change or a check. Checks should be made out to Liberty Road Faith Fellowship with Assurance written on the memo line.
