## *A Word from Our Pastor*

*But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you. John 14:26 (ESV)*

Jesus' tone of voice that night in the Garden of Gethsemane must have sounded *severe*. He was preparing the remaining 11 disciples for the time to come when he would no longer be with them. He was counting on them, as he counts on us, to continue the kingdom work that he ushered in.

Teresa of Avila, a Carmelite nun, is credited with the following writing.

*Christ has no body but yours, No hands, no feet on earth but yours,  
Yours are the eyes with which he looks in compassion on this world,  
Yours are the feet with which he walks to do good,  
Yours are the hands with which he blesses all the world.*

Ours are the hands, ours are the feet, ours are the eyes, and we are his body in whom his Holy Spirit lives. Jesus encouraged his disciples that, although he was going away, he would not leave them without a “power source.” The Helper would be their “...Comforter, Counselor, Keeper,” and remind them of the things he'd taught them.
