A Word from Our Pastor

Teach me your way, O Lord, that I may walk in your truth; give me an undivided heart to revere your name. Psalm 86: 11

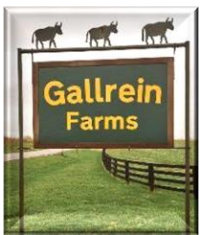
