A Word from Our Pastor

Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord. Psalm 33:12

I grew up hearing stories from my dad, a WWII veteran, about how thankful he was that God had protected and sustained him during “The War.” He recalled standing on the roof of a house in Naples watching the rising smoke and ash from the eruption of Mt. Vesuvius; he told of “marching up the boot of Italy” when an Italian family, fleeing their home, approached his company, begging the men to buy some of their belongings so they would have money for food. (Daddy caved to their desperate pleas and that’s how my mother came in possession of a beautiful little tea set.)

Daddy kept so many stories to himself. The horrors of war that he experienced were too terrible to talk about, but there was never a discussion on the subject that didn’t end with his overwhelming expressions of thanksgiving to God for the men and women who sacrificed so much - in some cases, everything - for our country and the freedoms we enjoy. “Never, and I mean never, take it for granted that you live in this great nation,” he repeated over and over again. “Pray for our country, Honey. Pray for our leaders. Never, never take any of this for granted.”

As we celebrate our nation’s 250th birthday this weekend, I hope you will join me in pausing amidst the fireworks and cookouts, binge-watching “The Patriot” and “Turn,” and lift a prayer for our nation.

Sovereign Lord, We give thanks for our freedom of religious expression that allows us to gather as a fellowship of faith, for our freedom to say what we think without fear of persecution by our governing authorities, and freedom to dream our own dreams and strive to make them come true. Keeneland's Track Kitchen offers cafeteria-style breakfast

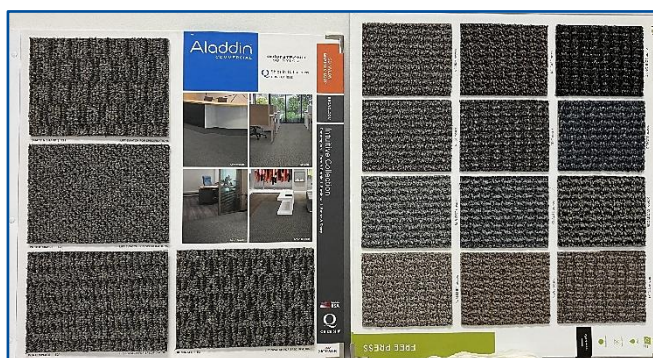

You're invited to join the Wildcards for a morning of card making and creativity on **Tuesday, July 14, at 9:30 a.m.** Whether you are experienced or just

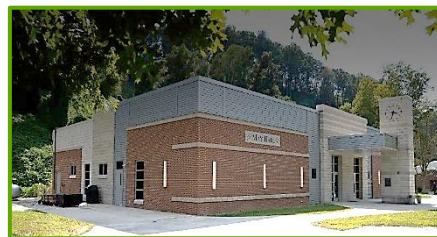
curious, enjoy the fun as we make cards to brighten someone's day.
