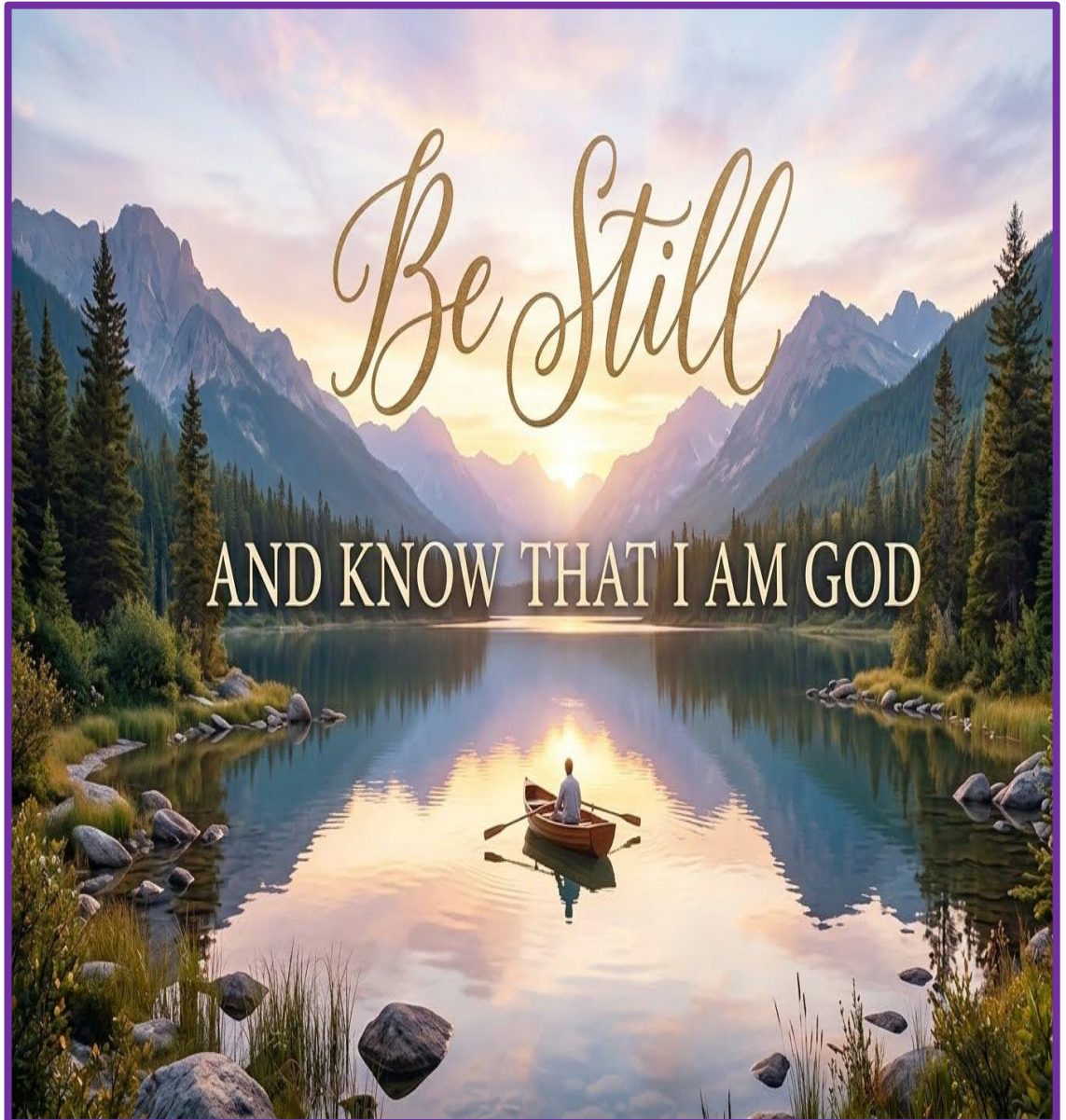

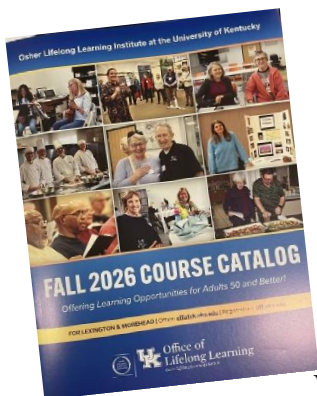


Help Us Stock the Teachers' Pantry
