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A Word from Our Pastor

This is what Frederick Buechner wrote concerning miracles.

A cancer inexplicably cured. A voice in a dream. A statue that weeps. A miracle is an event that strengthens faith. It is possible to look at most miracles and find a rational explanation in terms of natural cause and effect. It is possible to look at Rembrandt's Supper at Emmaus and find a rational explanation in terms of paint and canvas.

Faith in God is less apt to proceed from miracles than miracles from faith in God.

The Bible is full of accounts of God answering prayers in a miraculous way, but it is also full of stories about how God took the initiative to intervene in human circumstances and lives were spared, lives were *changed*, and nature itself submitted to the power of its Sovereign Creator.

It's likely that we've all prayed for something we would have considered "miraculous." But are the *eyes of our hearts* open to the miraculous works of God in the ordinary days? You could probably list a number of examples of your own, but here are a few of mine:

- A bus carrying 31 people flips twice on a busy interstate highway with no lives lost.
- Four babies are born to an "infertile" couple.
- An F3 tornado cuts a swath through a neighborhood, narrowly missing the home of an elderly veteran.
- Human flesh regenerates itself to repair wounds and injuries.

Love wins!

We don't know what we don't know, and we'll never have all the answers for why things are the way they are in this life. But we can have faith in God, *in spite of the way things are*, and just maybe discover that we are the miracle.
