I want to thank you for your calls, texts, cards, and prayers for me during this time of healing and recovery. Thank you for your concern for my daughter, Melissa, whose cancer is advancing. I am exceedingly grateful for the many times and ways you remind me that this pilgrim pathway is not one I walk alone. Yours is a generous grace, and I'm thankful God's plan for LRFF includes all of us.

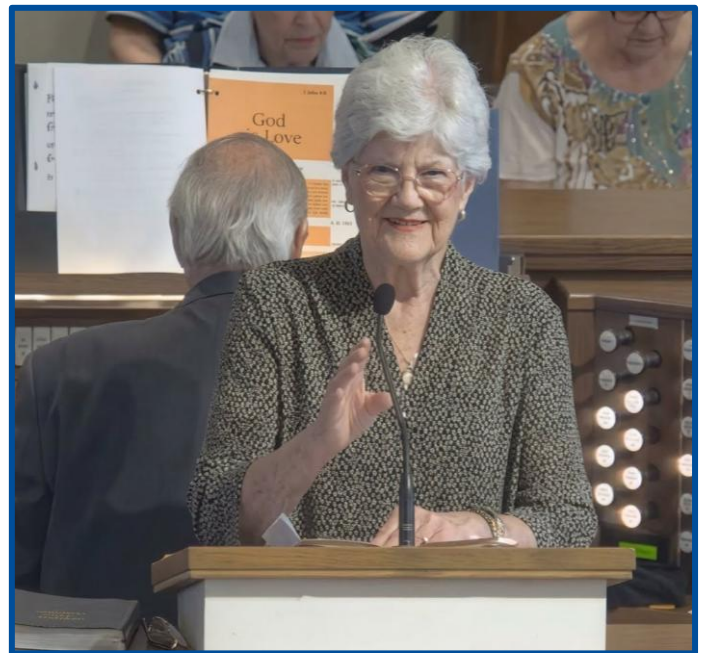
